Publicity- Kristen, Liz A- nothing to publicize; CN flyer came in the utility bill

Roger said money is still available if we need this year or next year

Kristen will talk with CN about having Obie with the Touch-a-Trucks also and possibly have a tent with information

Security -Roger- anticipate it will be same as planned for 4th; he mentioned concern voiced by the Chief about an excess of people that may attend because of other events being cancelled and if Governor concerns/rules will be in effect and possible protestors; It also gets darker earlier

Grounds-John, Dean, Chris- N/A

Beer Garden- would be set up the same way as 4th of July; waiting on Beer Geeks to finish up contract to get to Michael Griffin; our backup option would be Malt Brothers

Fall Festival- Lance and Dawn from Main Street were present to discuss Fall Festival and Marker's Market possibly being run in conjunction with one another. Said they would present information at their next meeting with their board who would make the final decisions

Roger acknowledged that HMS should extend to 2 days also to encourage more crafters

Trunk of Treat – discussed with Lance and Dawn bringing in businesses from Main Street to participate also

Santa Parade-28th of November – discussed business participation

Possibly moving earlier in the day; Chris mentioned if it was moved earlier maybe we should look at having other events coinciding such as a scavenger hunt

Also that need to have events at the park to keep people there, possibly reindeer

Dave mentioned frozen beer garden/cocktails

Alex likes parades and lighting of tree together
