Nothing Bundt Cakes from Schererville brought in a full size cake and cake squares for all.

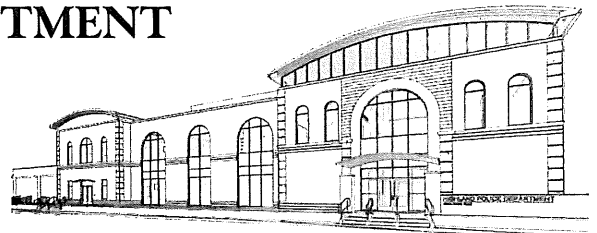

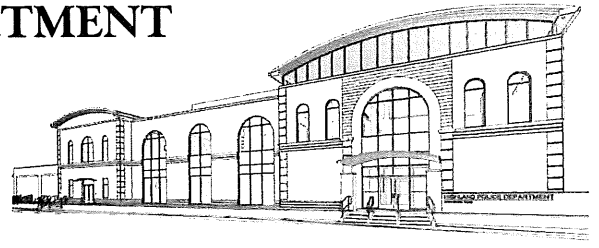
