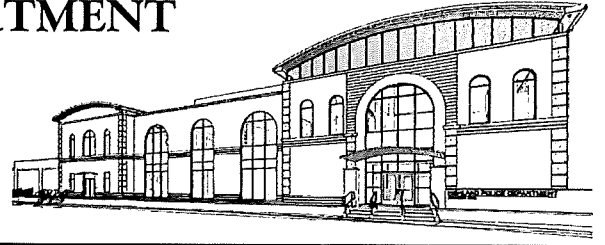

Councilman Herak thanked the Police Commission for their participation this year and wished all a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.

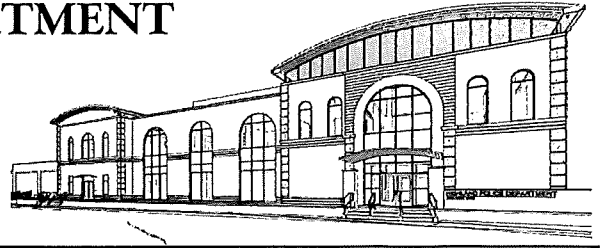
