

TRAFFIC SAFETY MEETING
March 7, 2023

The Traffic Safety Commission met in person at 3315 Ridge Road, Highland Police Dept. Chief Potesta called the meeting to order at 8:02 A.M.

Mr. Blane Roberts spoke of residents' concerns for the vehicular traffic speeding from Indianapolis Blvd EB and WB on Lincoln Street. Public works Director Mark Knesek stated he would post a Speed Limit sign at WB Lincoln as it seemed there was not one in the immediate area. Commander Banasiak advised as weather breaks our digital speed signs would be posted on Lincoln Street between Branton and Waymond for approximately 3 weeks. Further Robyn Pappenheim of DVG Team would check on the road widths for the possibility of painting narrowing lines in the area.

Public Works Director Mark Knesek stated he found LED lighting that could go onto the existing signage posted, since no other signage can be installed/posted into the ground area because of underground pipes. On a motion by Public Works Director Mark Knesek and a second by Police Commissioner Steve Jurczak with the Traffic Safety Committee concurring, the LED flashing lights would be purchased and the costs split between Public Works and the Police Department for 2 sets at approximately \$1,000 each.
